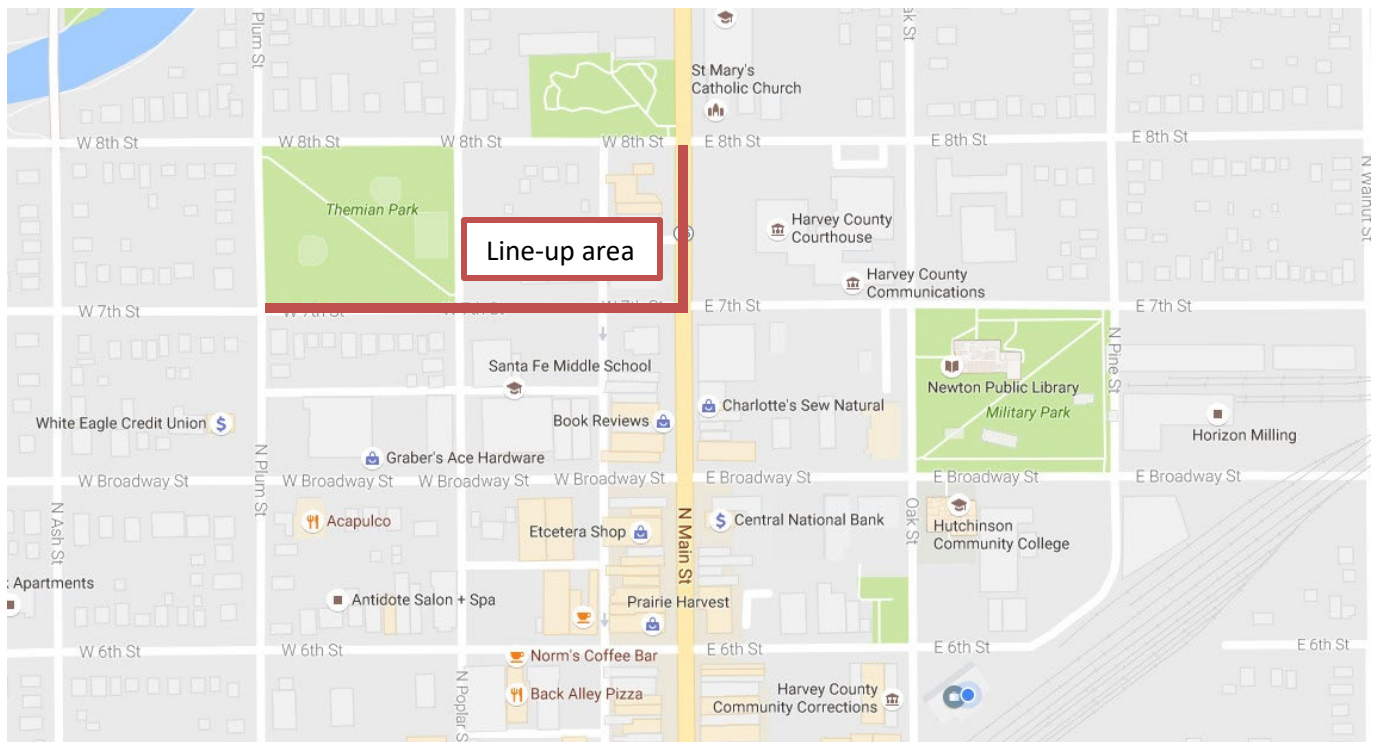

## Parade Instructions/Rules:

- All participants should be checked in and in the lineup by **6 pm**.
- Entry numbers will be issued at check-in and placed on the left front corner of the entry.
- All entries must have a minimum of 200 lights and a Christmas theme.
- Automotive tail lights, headlights and flashers should remain off.
- All groups in the parade should have a uniform theme.
- All floats must comply with City ordinances.
- Only one Santa Claus is allowed in the parade and will be furnished by the Newton Lions Club.
- **City ordinance prohibits throwing candy from parade floats.** It is dangerous for children who may run into the street. You may have people walk alongside your float passing out candy. Lions Club members also will walk the parade route handing out candy.

**Check in at the corner of West 7<sup>th</sup> and Main. You will be instructed where to line up along either Main Street or West 7<sup>th</sup> Street.**



## Entry Fee:

- Your generous **donation** will be accepted as your entry fee for the Parade of Lights!
- Net proceeds will go to fund the Newton Lions Club's efforts to provide eyeglasses and eye exams for needy people in Newton and other community needs.
